

Lewis Carroll once stated, "Who in the world am I? Ah, that's the great puzzle." In the hopes of answering his question, you will create a mixed media piece of art which conveys a sense of who you are. This art piece will consist of two layers representing your two selves, your **Inside Self** and your **Outside Self**.

**Outside Self** – What do people see on the outside? Who do they think you are? What misconceptions might people have about you? What pieces of yourself do you allow people to see?

**Inside Self** – What parts of yourself do you keep hidden? What qualities about yourself do only your closest friends and family members get to see? What dreams and aspirations do you have for your Future Self? Who are you really?

Both layers can be constructed out of corkboard, cardboard, foam board, poster board, etc. Be creative! Just make sure the backing of your project is strong and sturdy and can support your art supplies. Some decorative supply options are shown below, but you can essentially use whatever mixed media you choose to complete the assignment. Once the pieces are completed, you will put them together (the outside layer on top of the inside layer) using metal rings, which will be provided.
